IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF J. H. HENDERSON FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER FROM HURRICANE CREEK.

ORDER

Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer of Oregon on the application of J. H. Henderson, and it appearing:

That on the 10th day of February, 1922, Certificate of Water Right No. 3542 was issued to the Alder Slope Ditch Company under Permit No. 4805, covering, among other lands, a water right for 20 acres in NW 1824 of Section 9, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., from Hurricane Creek. That on October 20, 1922, by order of the State Water Board, 10 acres of the above described land was transferred to SW 1824, said section.

That the applicant herein now proposes to transfer the remaining 10 acres in NW1NE1 to a 10 acre tract in SW1NE1, said section.

That the water can be more beneficially used on the tract upon which it is proposed to make the transfer, and that it is to the mutual benefit of all parties concerned.

And it further appears that the Alder Slope Ditch Company has submitted its approval in writing to said transfer and that no other water rights will be injured by the proposed change.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved without loss of priority as heretofore established. It is further ordered that said water to be transferred shall be applied to 10 acres in SW2NE4, Section 9, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., within one year from date of this order, provided that such period of time as fixed herein shall be

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subject to extension by order of the State Engineer for good cause shown.
