O R D E R

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Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for con-
sideration before the State Engineer of Oregon on the application of
J. H. Henderson, and it appearing:

That on the 10th day of February, 1922, Certificate of Water
Right No. 3542 was issued to the Alder Slope Ditch Company under Permit
No. 4805, covering, among other lands, a water right for 20 acres in
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., from Hurricane
Creek. That on October 20, 1922, by order of the State Water Board, 10
acres of the above described land was transferred to SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said section.

That the applicant herein now proposes to transfer the remain-
ing 10 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to a 10 acre tract in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, said section.

That the water can be more beneficially used on the tract upon
which it is proposed to make the transfer, and that it is to the mutual
benefit of all parties concerned.

And it further appears that the Alder Slope Ditch Company has
submitted its approval in writing to said transfer and that no other
water rights will be injured by the proposed change.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in
place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved without loss
of priority as heretofore established. It is further ordered that said
water to be transferred shall be applied to 10 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section
9, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M., within one year from date of
this order, provided that such period of time as fixed herein shall be
