ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6241 submitted by

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to use the waters of A WELL in the PINE CREEK BASIN for the purpose of the PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 183.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 84.8 ACRES.

The rights to be transferred, are evidenced by certificate 30531, which was perfected under Permit U-711 with a date of priority of March 4, 1955, and certificate 61092, perfected under Permit G-9865 with a date of priority of February 19, 1980. The rights are limited to 3.09 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 6 N, R 34 E, W.M.; 310 FEET SOUTH AND 1020 FEET EAST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 6 N, R 34 E, W.M.; 1281 FEET NORTH AND 551 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to an appropriation of water to make up any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change is complete. The claim of beneficial use shall be submitted in accordance with the transmittal letter.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation shall not exceed 3.09 CFS.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificates 30531 and 61092 are canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights and correcting the number of primary and supplemental acres will be issued.
