ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6660 submitted by

BILLY L. COFFER 281220 MILL CREEK RD. PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

The rights to be modified were confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY as evidenced by PORTIONS of Certificates 601 AND 686. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 325 AND 420-1. The date of priority is 1868.

The right allows the use of MILL CREEK, a tributary of OCHOCO CREEK, for IRRIGATING 34.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, if available at the authorized point of diversion: STANTON DITCH, SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, SECTION 10; STANTON & EVANS DITCH, SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, SECTION 11, BOTH IN T. 14 S., R. 17 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 10.6 ACRES SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 0.9 ACRE SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 23.2 ACRES

Section 15

Township 14 South, Range 17 East W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion at:

SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 15, T. 14 S., R. 17 E., W.M.; 915 FEET NORTH AND 885 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 15.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversions, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

Certificates 601 and 686 are canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
