ORDER

Now at this time the above entitled proceeding coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of the West Side Irrigation and Water Ditch Company, by its Secretary, F. L. Pearce, and

It appearing that by decree of the Circuit Court for Wallowa County dated January 20, 1919, a water right was recognized in the name of the West Side Irrigation and Water Ditch Company for the irrigation of 1,264 acres in Sections 5, 8, 9, 15, 16, 17, 22, and 27, Township 1 South, Range 43 East, W.M., and Section 31, Township 1 North, Range 43 East, W.M., through the West Side Ditch with a date of priority of March 27, 1901;


That the present point of diversion is located 200 feet North and 100 feet East from the center of Section 27 and being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township 1 South, Range 43 East, W.M.

That the applicant now proposes to change the point of diversion to a point located 152 feet South and 200 feet East from the center of Section 27 and being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township 1 South, Range 43 East, W.M., and

It further appears that the proposed point of diversion is less than one-quarter of a mile and that there are no intervening diversions between the present point of diversion and the proposed point of diversion, and that no other rights will be injured by such change,

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby ORDERED that said change in point of diversion be and the same is hereby approved.
