Order of Proper Proof of Change in Place of Use and Character of Use Under Transfer Application T-9129, Hood River County)

This order confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK HOOD RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF HOOD RIVER, FOR INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for HOOD RIVER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 17 at Page 333. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 25, 1895.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.135 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The period of allowed use is restricted to the season April 15 to October 1 of each year and shall not exceed a total diversion of 32.4 acre-feet per season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This order is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 25, 2002, in Special Order Volume 56, Pages 1037 - 1039, approving Transfer Application T-9129.

Water right certificate 81340 (formerly 74642) is modified. The Department shall issue a water right certificate on a determination that it is necessary to produce a certificate describing the water right.
