Findings of Fact

- 1. Permit G-17236 allows for the use of 12.48 CFS (and 3682.7 acre-feet) of water from nine wells in the Crooked River Basin for municipal use. The date of priority is June 27, 2007.
- 2. On July 9, 2018, the Department received an Affidavit for the partial diminution of Permit G-17236 to cancel 4.46 cubic feet per second (CFS) of water (and a commensurate volume of 1,322 acre-feet) for municipal use.
- 3. The Department has determined City of Prineville is the permit holder of record, as established by county deed records, of Permit G-17236 that is subject to the Affidavit.

Conclusions of Law

The Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the portion of Permit G-17236 shall be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Permit G-17236 is cancelled and is of no further force or effect.
- 2. The Department shall issue Permit G-18155 to describe the remaining portion of the permit NOT cancelled by the provisions of this order.
