On September 14, 1959, C.F. Henrichs of Route 2, Box 166A, Milton-Freewater, Oregon, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalum or Little Walla Walla River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, Oregon, entered May 16, 1932, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River and its tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Milton-Freewater and Hudson Bay Irrigation Company for the irrigation of, among other lands, 39.5 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, from Tumalum or Little Walla Walla River through the Hudson Bay Ditch, with a date of priority of February 16, 1903.

The Order of the State Engineer entered October 14, 1959, in Volume 10, page 186, Special Order Record, approving Transfer H-110, allowed a change in place of use for 10.0 acres of said right.

It appears that the lands owned by aforesaid C. F. Henrichs and divested of said water right totaled 8.0 acres, not 10.0 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that paragraph 3, page 186, Volume 10, Special Order Record, be amended to sever the water right from 8.0 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, and to place said 8.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 19, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued as provided for by the order approving Transfer H-110.
