

Transfer Application E-34, in the name of Arthur C. Edwards, proposed a change in use of water from Evans Creek under a certain right with a priority date of December 2, 1946, to irrigate a certain 18.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM.

The order of the State Engineer, predecessor of the Water Resources Director, entered February 14, 1961, approving Transfer Application E-34, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1962."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the subject water right was lost.
