ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8390 submitted by

CHESTER PRIOR 32327 OREGON TRAIL ROAD ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 54564, was perfected under Permit G-6588 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 15, 1975. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 267.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.34 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ NE¼, SECTION 10, T 2 N, R 28 E, WM; 1020 FEET SOUTH AND 1670 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 10, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 54565, was perfected under Permit G-7014 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 15, 1976. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 108.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.36 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ NE¼, SECTION 10, T 2 N, R 28 E, WM; 1020 FEET SOUTH AND 1670 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 10, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The change is temporary. The change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
- 2. The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 irrigation seasons.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2004 irrigation season, or sooner if requested by the applicant. The approval of this temporary transfer is revoked if a permanent transfer is approved for the same water rights and same lands.
- 5. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right, upon request of the applicant, or upon approval of a permanent transfer for substantially the same changes.
