ORDER

On July 31, 1997, Gary G. and Bonnie Bradley, submitted an affidavit to the Water Resources Department that they are the owners of certain land and a water right appurtenant to it. The affidavit further states the water right has been abandoned requests its cancellation.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right evidenced by Certificate 13399, State Record of Water Right Certificates, namely the right to use 0.03 cubic foot per second from Birch Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River for irrigation of 1.7 acres with a priority date of May 27, 1937.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  1.7 Acres  
Section 9  
Township 1 South, Range 32 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 13399 is canceled and a new certificate of water right describing that portion of the water right not canceled by the provisions of this order be issued.
