ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7465 submitted by

BILLY GYDESEN

SILVERTON, OREGON 97381.

The water use permit to be modified is Permit G-13454, with a date of priority of JULY 2, 1993. The permit allows the use of THREE WELLS, in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION 270.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.38 cubic foot per second, if available at the original wells; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 15, T 7 S, R 2 W, WM; WELL 1 - 900 FEET NORTH AND 130 FEET EAST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 14, WELL 2 - 1360 FEET NORTH AND 580 FEET EAST, WELL 3 - 100 FEET NORTH AND 750 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 15, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

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
The applicant proposes to add an additional point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, T 7 S, R 2 W, WM; 900 FEET NORTH AND 127 FEET EAST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 14.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER USE PERMIT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE PERMIT HOLDER:

1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
2. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Permit G-11804, in the name of Billy Gydesen, is amended as described herein. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.
