FOR APPROVAL OF A DIMINUTION OF)
A WATER RIGHT)

On September 22, 1986, a petition was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Pendleton Country Club, Inc for approval of a change from primary to supplemental use of water from Birch Creek.

The certificate recorded at page 2610, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of S.H. Rockwell, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from Birch Creek for irrigation of a certain 1.9 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 32 East, WM, with a date of priority of 1894.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 700 feet South and 1800 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 22, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 32 East, WM.


The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the right from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation on the same lands.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed diminution of water right may be made without injury to existing rights, the petition should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein be included as supplemental irrigation in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered August 27, 1986, approving transfer Application 5808.
