## ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE AND A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6708 submitted by

ROSEBURG FOREST PRODUCTS P.O. BOX 1088 ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 17297, was perfected under Permit 16335 with a date of priority of MAY 16, 1945. The right allows the use of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for LOG POND USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.34 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE¼ SW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN MCCLOUD DLC 41, SECTION 33, T 28 S, R 6 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 17243, was perfected under Permit R-817 with a date of priority of MAY 16, 1945. The right allows the storage of the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for LOG STORAGE USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 285 acre-feet.

NOTICE: Under the provisions of OAR 137-004-0080, the applicant may petition for reconsideration of this order. The petition shall set forth specific grounds for reconsideration. The petition for reconsideration must be filed within 60 days after the date this order is served.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an inline flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

Certificates 17243 and 17297 are cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
