# ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8713 submitted by

The FIRST right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 52617, was perfected under Permit G-8841 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 13, 1980. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 15, T 25 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W¼ CORNER, SECTION 15, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The SECOND right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 52637, was perfected under Permit G-9137 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 23, 1980. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 37.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.47 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE½ SE½, SECTION 16, T 25 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1000 FEET NORTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 16, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further

limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The applicant proposes to change the points of appropriation to:

NE% SW%, SECTION 21, T 28 S, R 14 E, W.M.; NORTH 48° 06' 06" EAST 3433 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 21.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2003.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificates 52617 and 52637 is canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming these water rights will be issued.
