On May 18, 1990, a request was received in the office of the Water Resources Director from John D. Miller, President, Miller Forest, Inc., the owner of certain land and the groundwater registration appurtenant to it, for approval of a <u>change from primary irrigation</u> to <u>supplemental irrigation</u> from the waters of a well.

Certificate of Registration GR-3077, State Record of Groundwater Registration Records, issued to LaVern H. Dalkenberg, describes a claim to the use of 600 to 800 gallons per minute from a well with a tentative priority date of February 10, 1951, for the irrigation of:

It appears that the proposed diminution of the water right may be made without injury to existing water rights. Therefore, the request should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed change from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation of said lands is approved without loss of priority.
