O R D E R

An affidavit was received from HELEN C. GRANING, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 12517, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of one miner's inch of water from the WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER. The date of priority is 1888. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 0.26 ACRE.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.26 ACRE
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.


more explicitly described as:

LOT 4, BLOCK 5, TAX LOT 6300
CITY OF MILTON

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 12517 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
