confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-19963. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS AND UNNAMED STREAMS FORMED THEREBY, A TRIBUTARY OF CLEAR CREEK

PURPOSE OR USE: STOCK USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS)

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 6, 1950 FOR 0.50 CFS AND DECEMBER 2, 1950 FOR 0.50 CFS.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

5 S	9 E	WM	13	NW SE NW	1400 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 13
5 S	9 E	WM	13	NE NE SE	340 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 77734.

This order is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 4, 2011, at Special Order Volume 83, Page 683, approving Transfer Application 10936, supercedes Certificate 77734, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that it is necessary for record keeping.
