Whereas, the City of Forest Grove has submitted an application,

being Application No. 15790, for permit to appropriate 2 cubic feet per second of the waters of Clear and Eiler Creeks for municipal use to supplement appropriations already made from Clear Creek, and have requested that this application be approved to the exclusion of all subsequent appropriations of any of the waters of Clear or Eiler Creeks and their tributaries originating west of the line running north and south between Township 1 North, Range 5 West of Willamette Meridian, and Township 1 North, Range 4 West of Willamette Meridian, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the State Engineer that the entire flow of the streams named, originating west of the aforesaid line, should be preserved as a municipal supply for this municipality and no appropriations of such waters should be made which would conflict in any manner with the future appropriations of such waters by this municipality, and

WHEREAS, the State Engineer is authorized, under the provisions of Section 47-503, Oregon Code 1930, to approve applications of municipalities to the exclusion of all subsequent appropriations if the exigencies of the case demand,

IT IS ORDERED that said Application No. 15790 be and the same is hereby approved to the exclusion of all subsequent appropriations of any the waters of Clear or Eiler Creeks, or their tributaries originating west of the line running north and south between Township: 1 North, Range 5 West of Willamette Meridian and Township 1 North, Range 4 West of Willamette Meridian.
