**Findings of Fact**

1. On January 26, 2021, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-13405, involving Certificate 93735. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 118, Page 421.
2. Certificate 93735 is recognized by the Department as a Living Certificate. The order contained a scrivener's error in not including the required language for Living Certificates.
3. Condition number 3, under **Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**, inadvertently stated the following:

*“Water right Certificates 38691, 57718, and 93735 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of Certificate 57718 not affected by this transfer.”*
4. Condition number 3, under **Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**, is modified to read as follows:

*“Water right Certificates 38691 and 57718 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued describing that portion of Certificate 57718 not affected by this transfer.”*
5. A new condition number 4, under **Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**, is included and reads as follows:


*“Water right certificate 93735 is modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing the right when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.”*

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The order approving T-13405, as recorded in Special Order Volume 118, Page 421, is modified to correctly describe the certificates cancelled and to include the required Living Certificate language associated with the modifications made to Certificate 93735 as a result of this transfer.

2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 118, Page 421 remain in effect.
