On April 10, 1986, a petition was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Duckwall-Pooley Fruit Company for approval of a change from primary to supplemental use of water from a well.

The certificate recorded at page 28661, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Duckwall Brothers, Inc., describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second from a well for industrial use within NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM, with a date of priority of May 21, 1958.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 639 feet North and 560 feet East from the Southwest Corner of NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM.


The affiant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the right from primary industrial use to supplemental industrial use on the same lands.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed diminution of water right may be made without injury to existing rights, the petition should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change from primary industrial use to supplemental industrial use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 28661, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and a certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein designating said water right as supplemental on the aforesaid lands.
