

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the petition of F. W. Johnson and Mrs. Constance Johnson for permission to transfer water right now appurtenant to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NB $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section, and it appearing that the proposed change would result in a more economical use of the water, and could be made without detriment to other rights, as the land to which the water right is now appurtenant is covered with gravel, and has been washed away by McKay Creek and it has become impracticable to beneficially use water for the irrigation thereof, and the said tract to which it is proposed to transfer the water right has been irrigated for several years and is in alfalfa; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that such transfer be and the same is hereby approved, and the water right heretofore appurtenant to 6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 T. 2 N. R. 32 E. W. M., be transferred to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NB $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section, without loss of priority of the right heretofore established.
