An affidavit was received from Robert Fessler, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 56624, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.39 cubic foot per second from well 2, in the Bocksler Creek Basin. The date of priority is September 15, 1977. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 31.3 acres.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:


NW 1/4 SE 1/4 29.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.8 ACRES
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of water from well 1 for irrigation of 41.5 acres is not at issue in this proceeding.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 56624 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
