
Findings of Fact

1. On June 16, 2005, Bill Roats of Roats Water System filed an application requesting to change the point of appropriation under Certificates 81657 and 81672. The Department assigned the application number T-9955.
2. On May 8, 2007, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer T-9955. This order was recorded in the Department's Special Order Volume 72, Page 8.
3. A final order approving an extension of time through October 1, 2010, for Transfer T-9955 was issued by the Department on October 15, 2008, as evidenced by Special Order Volume 76, Page 463.
4. On November 17, 2009, the applicant submitted a letter to the Department requesting to revert Transfer Application T-9955 because the applicant did not plan to prove up on the point of appropriation change associated with that transfer.
5. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010, the point of appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of appropriation if the change is not completed.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Because the point of appropriation change will not be completed, Transfer T-9955 is reverted. Special Order Volume 72, Page 8, is of no further force or effect. Superseding certificates for the rights affected by the transfer shall be issued in the name of Roats Water System, Inc.
