## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Charles G. and Carlleen C. Hegele, Lessor #1, Crook County Improvement District, Lessor #2, and Deschutes Resource Conservancy, Lessee, submitted a short-term lease application on June 19, 2003. The Department issued an order approving renewal of the short-term lease on July 21, 2003. The order was filed at Special Order Volume 57, page 1053.
- 2. Subsequent to issuance of the order, the Department identified that Lessor #2 was incorrectly identified on the Final Order as Arnold Irrigation District. This Final Order is being issued to correctly identify Lessor #2 as Crook County Improvement District.
- 3. The conditions of the original Final Order remain the same.
- 4. The lease application includes the required information under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were received.
- 5. Based upon review of the application and information provided by the Department's Watermaster, the Department finds that the lease, as proposed, will not result in injury or enlargement.
- 6. The lessor shall have the option of terminating the lease each year, prior to the lease being exercised, with 30 days written notice to the Department.
- 7. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2007.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

## **ORDER**

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Short-Term Lease, as modified above, described herein is APPROVED.
