ORDER

On November 15, 1996, Alice S. Juve of 10655 SW Hall Blvd, Portland, Oregon, 97223-8744, submitted an affidavit that she is the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The affidavit further states a portion of the water right has been abandoned and authorizes its cancellation.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 67324 State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of not to exceed 0.0047 cubic feet per second of water with a priority date of August 15, 1932 and 0.0128 cubic feet per second of water with a priority date of October 1, 1932, from Ash Creek, a tributary of Fanno Creek, for the irrigation of 1.46 acres.

A description of the place of use that has been abandoned is as follows:

1.46 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 35
Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 67324 is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right not involved in this proceeding.
