On November 6, 1996, Stanley G. And Leonna Gray, of 10870 NW LaCassel, Portland, Oregon, 97229, submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The affidavit further states a portion of the water right has been abandoned authorizes its cancellation..

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 23473 State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second of water from Fanno Creek, a tributary of the Tualatin River, for the irrigation of 2.4 acres. The date of priority is April 12, 1950.

A description of the place of use that has been abandoned is as follows:

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that Certificate 23473 is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right not involved in this proceeding.
