OF THE STATE OF OREGON

In the Matter of the Proposed Short-Term (1) FINAL ORDER WITHDRAWING Lease of Existing Water Rights for Instream (1) INSTREAM LEASE Use, Lane County

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.348 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to lease an existing water right for instream purposes. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 077 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating instream lease applications.

Findings of Fact

- On May 10, 2021, Lane County Public Works filed an application to lease a portion of Certificate 36521 for instream use. The Department assigned the application number IL-1869.
- 2. On May 18, 2021, the Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were filed in response to this notice.
- 3. On June 14, 2021, the Department received a request from Lane County Public Works to withdraw the lease application.

Conclusions of Law

The Department concludes that this lease has been withdrawn and does not result in the protection of any instream flow pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore it is ORDERED:

The Short-Term Lease application described herein is withdrawn.
