ORDER

The Clackamas Water District is the holder of permit No. 34426 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 6.5 cubic feet per second of water from Clackamas River for municipal use.

The District has advised that construction was started in August, 1971, and the system is being expanded within the permit area.


The District has further advised that the water purification plant has been expanded from 10 million gallons per day capacity to 20 million gallons per day capacity.

It is the District's desire to preserve the right and an extension of time has been requested.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits to complete construction and make complete application of water under permit No. 34426 be extended to October 1, 1975.
