ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6290 submitted by

RONALD M. KILGORE STAR ROUTE, BOX 700 PENDLETON, OREGON 97801

to use the waters of A WELL in the STAGE GULCH BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 184.6 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 53552, was perfected under Permit G-7965 with a date of priority of May 23, 1977. The right is limited to 2.31 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 4 N, R 30 E, W.M.; 2640 FEET NORTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 24.2 ACRES SW 1/4 NW 1/4 29.2 ACRES SECTION 26

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 32.0 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 33.6 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 32.0 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 33.6 ACRES SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 53552 was canceled with the order approving transfer 5939. The order also provided for the issuance of a certificate describing that part not involved in the change in place of use of water. Since those lands are addressed in the order approving T-6290, when satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
