ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6622 submitted by

CHARLES J. AND MABEL VIRGINIA LEIBELT HC 85 BOX 591 MYRTLE POINT, OREGON 97458.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 39385, was perfected under Permit 29442 with a date of priority of MARCH 10, 1964. The right allows the use of the NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE OF ONE FAMILY. This right is limited to 0.005 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 9 (SW¼ SE¼), SECTION 2, T 29 S, R 12 W, WM; 1230 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, LOT 8 (SE¼ SW¼), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

LOT 9 (NW¼ SE¼)
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicants propose to change the place of use to:

LOT 8 (SE% SW%)
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The applicants propose to change the point of diversion to:

LOT 9 (SW% SE%), SECTION 2, T 29 S, R 12 W, WM; 819.9 FEET NORTH AND 1447.5 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, LOT 8 (SE% SW%).

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

 The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.

- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The former place of use shall no longer receive water for domestic use as a part of this water right.

Certificate 39385 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
