O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION

On April 21, 1937, Minnie F. Storch, of San Francisco, California, filed an application for approval of a change in place of use of water from Glade Fork of Williams Creek.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, dated April 26, 1919, a water right was recognized in the name of Louis Storch for the irrigation of 7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W. M., from Glade Fork of Williams Creek, with a date of priority of October 4, 1899.

The applicant herein, owner of the above-described lands, proposes to transfer the water rights appurtenant to said lands to 7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Tom R. Pearce, watermaster of district #16, has submitted a report to the effect that existing rights would not be injured by the proposed change.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved, and that the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., having a date of priority of October 4, 1899, be severed therefrom and simultaneously, and without loss of priority, transferred to 7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that complete application of water to beneficial use on said land shall be made on or before October 1, 1938.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of the complete application of water to such beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Minnie F. Storch or her successor in interest to said lands when and at the time certificates are issued confirming the rights to the use of the waters of Rogue River and its tributaries.
