O R D E R

An affidavit was received from TRECO, Oregon Rootstock and Tree Company, Inc., the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 16879, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.184 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream, a tributary of Pudding River. The date of priority is November 30, 1942. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 14.7 acres.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) 0.7 ACRE
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.4 ACRES
SECTION 29

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 6.6 ACRES
SECTION 32


TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of 0.216 cubic foot per second from Pudding River for the irrigation of 17.3 acres under certificate 16879 is not part of this cancellation. Of the 17.3 acres, 8.4 acres is unchanged and the remaining 8.9 acres is to be transferred under application 6431.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 16879 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding or transferred under application 6431.
