ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6549 submitted by

JOHN FOLKERTS 7746 WABASH DRIVE NE BROOKS, OREGON 97305.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 39918, was perfected under Permit G-4949 with a date of priority of JUNE 1, 1970. The right allows the use of a WELL, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 24.7 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.31 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; $NW^{\frac{1}{4}}$, as projected within BONIN DLC 53, SECTION 2, T 6 S, R 2 W; 20 FEET SOUTH AND 530 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF BONIN DLC 53, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ 0.5 ACRE
SW¼ NW¼ 16.8 ACRES
NW¼ SW¼ 7.4 ACRES
all as projected within BONIN DLC 53
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to add an additional point of appropriation to:

NW\\ SE\\, as projected within PRUETTS DLC 57, SECTION 2, T 6 S, R 2 W, WM; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 2340 FEET WEST FROM THE E\\ CORNER, SECTION 2.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.

- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverter from the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 39918 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
