ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 3527

On February 9, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Charles R. Topping for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 302-E, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, describes a right tabulated in the name of R. M. Wright which includes the use of water from Squaw Creek for irrigation of 10.0 acres in the E $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November, 1904.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Plainview Ditch, from a point located 800 feet North and 10 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 29, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom, and without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 10.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M.

The proposed change in place of use within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District has been approved by the Board of Directors of

the District in regular meeting.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Squaw Creek Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
