An affidavit was received from THERESA SMITH, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is described by Certificate 16878, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.044 cubic foot per second from AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 30, 1942. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 3.5 ACRES.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:


LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) 3.5 ACRES
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of groundwater for the irrigation of the above described land is not part of this cancellation.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 16878 is canceled.
