NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right for the use of 0.2 cubic foot per second of water from South unnamed drainage ditch with any deficiency in the available supply in South unnamed drainage ditch to be made up by diversion from Pudding River, for the irrigation of:

- 7.2 acres within the SE4 SW4, as projected within John C. Carey D.L.C. #58
- 14.0 acres within the SW4 SE4, as projected within John C. Carey D.L.C. #58 Section 5
- 23.2 acres within the NW% NE%, as projected within John C. Carey D.L.C. #58
- 11.0 acres within the NE% NW%, as projected within John C. Carey D.L.C. #58
- 0.2 acres within the NE¼ NW¼, as projected within Wm. Parker D.L.C. #49
