- 9. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 10. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. A pump, pipeline, and sprinker system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 13. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The changes in point of appropriation and place of use proposed in application T-9256 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Order

It is hereby ORDERED:

- 1. Transfer T-9256 is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions.
- 2. Certificates 41322 and 41330 are cancelled. Certificates 80644 and 80645 shall be issued to describe the remaining rights.
- 3. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 41322 and 41330 and any related decree.

- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
- 6. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2006.
- 7. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water that was lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 8. Prior to diverting water at the new point of appropriation, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
