**ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION (WELL LOCATION)  
PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE**

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6366 submitted by

to use the waters of A WELL in the KLAMATH RIVER BASIN for the purpose of MUNICIPAL USE.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 46975, was perfected under Permit G-3011 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 7, 1966. The right is limited to 0.50 cubic foot per second, if available at the original wells; NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 39 S, R 9 E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 65 FEET SOUTH AND 2190 FEET EAST; WELL 2 - 65 FEET SOUTH AND 2135 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation (well) is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 39 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 58 FEET SOUTH AND 2187 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 46975 is hereby canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
