The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.2 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ NW¼, SECTION 32, T 4 N, R 29 E, WM; 1240 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 32, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

- 1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 2. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
