OAR 690-380-6020 establish an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfers.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On September 4, 2015, the Department received an application for extension of time for Transfer Applications T-6726 and T-6727.
- 2. The Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-6726 on January 12, 2001. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Pages 25-27. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2002.
- 3. The Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-6727 on January 12, 2001. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Pages 28-31. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2002.
- 4. Based on the record, the applicant had installed the delivery system, including pumps and pipelines. During the time the water right was leased instream, and no irrigation occurred.
- 5. To fully complete the change, the applicant needs to install a fish screen, flow meter, and irrigate the 51.0 acres authorized by the transfer order.
- 6. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2019.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Applications T-6726 and T-6727.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the changes in place of use authorized by T-6726 and T-6727 shall be extended to October 1, 2019.
