**ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION**

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6152 submitted by

WILLIS E. or DORA MAE CAMPBELL  
8865 DAYS CREEK CUTOFF ROAD  
CANYONVILLE, OREGON 97417

to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 94.9 ACRES.

A portion of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 10534, was perfected under Permit 7798 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 21, 1927. This right is limited to 0.49 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) per acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The remainder of the right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 24132, was perfected under Permit 21377 with a date of priority of May 12, 1952. This right is limited to 0.70 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The new points of diversion for these rights are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 1660 FEET WEST, 1100 FEET NORTH AND 160 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 8.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:


1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The following described lands shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:
