ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6603 submitted by

ROSS IVERSON
33739 SOUTH MERIDIAN ROAD
WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 66071, was perfected under Permit G-7272 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 24 1977. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of the BUTTE CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.25 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 5 S, R 1 E, WM; 1046 FEET NORTH AND 1740 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 66072, was perfected under Permit G-8280 with a date of priority of JULY 5, 1978. The right allows the use of TWO WELLS, tributary of the BUTTE CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 69.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 89.2 ACRES. The right is limited to 1.15 cubic foot per second, being 0.54 cfs from Well 1 and 0.61 cfs from Well 2, if available at the original wells; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 5 S, T 1 E, WM; WELL 1 - 1046 FEET NORTH AND 1740 FEET EAST; WELL 2 - 1280 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the points of appropriation to:

SE¼ SW¼, NE¼ SE¼, NW¼ SE¼, SW¼ SE¼, as projected within NEWMAN DLC 73, SECTION 24, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM; WELL 1 - 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST, WELL 2 - 1280 FEET SOUTH AND 1140 FEET EAST, WELL 3 - 690 FEET SOUTH AND 1530 FEET EAST, WELL 4 - 1190 FEET SOUTH AND 1670 FEET EAST, WELL 5 - 440 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET EAST, HOUSE WELL - 2080 FEET SOUTH AND 440 FEET EAST, ALL FROM THE E'LY SE CORNER, CHASE DLC 46.

Water will be appropriated under the following priorities for use on the following places of use:

SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

THIS CHANGE TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

Certificates 66071 and 66072 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
