IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF IRA V. AND HELEN ANN WOOLFOLK FOR A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF WATER FROM ROCK CREEK, SCHOOL HOUSE CREEK AND WOOLFOLK RESERVOIR

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. W-115

On February 7, 1966, Ira V. and Helen Ann Woolfolk filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in character of use and place of use of water from Rock Creek, School House Creek and Woolfolk Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Ira V. Woolfolk and recorded at page 31157, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 1.01 cubic feet per second of the waters of School House Creek and Woolfolk Reservoir for the irrigation of, among other lands, 18.0 acres in the SEM SEM, Section 33, 2.4 acres in the SWM SWM, Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M., 18.2 acres in the NEM NEM, 24.9 acres in the SWM NEM, 2.0 acres in the NEM SEM, 4.6 acres in the NWM NEM and 11.0 acres in the SEM NEM, Section 4, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 1, 1954.

Certificate of water right issued to Ira V. Woolfolk and recorded at page 31158, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the storage of 480.0 acre feet of water from School House Creek for irrigation, with a date of priority of June 1, 1954.

Certificate of water right issued to Ira V. Woolfolk and recorded at page 31159, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 1.01 cubic feet per second of the waters of Rock Creek

and Woolfolk Reservoir for the supplemental irrigation of, among other lands, 18.0 acres in the SEM SEM, Section 33, 2.4 acres in the SWM SWM, Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M., 18.2 acres in the NEM NEM, 24.9 acres in the SWM NEM, 2.0 acres in the NEM SEM, 4.6 acres in the NWM NEM and 11.0 acres in the SEM NEM, Section 4, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of January 12, 1956.

Certificate of water right issued to Ira V. Woolfolk and recorded at page 31160, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the storage of 480.0 acre feet of water from Rock Creek for supplemental irrigation, with a date of priority of January 12, 1956.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands and reservoirs above described, propose to change the use heretofore made of water to fish culture and recreation use in a reservoir located in the NW/4 SW/4, SW/4 SW/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in character of use and place of use of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse at Medford, Oregon, on May 13, 1966, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 16, 23 and 30, 1966. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, mortgage holders of the lands from which it is proposed to transfer water, have submitted written approval to the change in use and place of use of water.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in use and place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use and place of use of ater may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the change in use and place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 18.0 acres in the SEM SEM, Section 33, 2.4 acres in the SW4 SW4. Section 34. Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M., 18.2 acres in the NEW NEWA, 24.9 acres in the SWW NEWA, 2.0 acres in the NEWA SEWA, 4.6 acres in the NWA NEW and 11.0 acres in the SEM NEW. Section 4. Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M. for irrigation, with a date of priority of June 1. 1954: 18.0 acres in the SMA SEA. Section 33. 2.4 acres in the SWA SWA. Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M., 18.2 acres in the NEW MENA, 4.6 acres in the NW4 NEW4. 24.9 acres in the SW4 NEW4. 11.0 acres in the SEM4 NEW4. 2.0 acres in the NEW SEW, Section 4, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M., for supplemental irrigation, with a date of priority of January 12, 1956; and the storage of water from School House Creek for irrigation under a priority date of June 1, 1954, and the storage of water from Rock Creek for supplemental irrigation under a priority date of January 12, 1956, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to, and storage for, recreation and fish culture in the NW/4 SW/4, SW/4 SW/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1967.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right heretofore issued to Ira V. Woolfolk and recorded at pages 31157, 31158, 31159 and 31160, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in use and place of use, certificates of water right shall

be issued to Ira V. and Helen Ann Woolfolk confirming the change in use and the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
