CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER) TRANSFER 6019

On November 12, 1987, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Frank B. Rood for approval of a change in place of use of water from an unnamed stream, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 53693, Volume 49, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank B. Rood, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream for domestic use for one family in Lot 3(NW1/4SW1/4), Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 17, 1977.

Water for said right is diverted from a point located 2060 feet South and 840 feet East from the Center Quarter corner of Section 18, being within the SW1/4SE1/4 of Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to the NW1/4SE1/4, Section 18, Township 25 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

John P. Drolet, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in Certificate 53693, and shall be beneficially used as authorized by this order on or before October 1, 1989.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 53693, Volume 49, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
