Findings of Fact

1. On May 18, 2017, the Department issued an order approving Transfer T-12408. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 104, Pages 998-1001. A remaining right certificate was issued as evidenced by Certificate 93118.
2. The order contained a scrivener's error in the rate described as follows:
111.732 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND 100.0 GPM FOR IRRIGATION AND RELATED NURSERY USE.
3. The correct description of the rate should be as follows:
111.728 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK AND 104.0 GPM FOR IRRIGATION AND RELATED NURSERY USE.
4. The remaining right Certificate 93118 contains a scrivener's error in the rate described as follows:
8.4 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) FOR IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES AND 138.268 GPM FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK USE ON 9.9 ACRES.
5. The correct description of the rate should be as follows:
6.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) FOR IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES AND 138.263 GPM FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY STOCK USE ON 9.9 ACRES.


Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order approving T-12408 as recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Pages 998-1001 is corrected to include the rate described in Finding No. 3 above.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. Water right Certificate 93118 is cancelled.
3. A water right certificate will be issued to supersede Certificate 93118 and to correctly describe the authorized rate.
4. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 104, Pages 998-1001 remain in effect.
