R. 1 W. W. M.; that recent negot ations in regard to said water rights have developed the fact that the lands described by said decree, and upon which the water under said right has been used, were incorrectly described in said decree; and that the correct description of the lands is as follows: 14 acres in NELSEL, and 6 acres in SELSEL, of Section 16, T. 38 S. R. 1 W. W. M.; and it further appearing that said error should be corrected and that no injury will be caused thereby, it is ORDERED that in the record of said water right in this office, said description be changed as above indicated, and at such time as a final water right certificate is assued covering said right, the correct description be incorporated therein.
