O R D E R.

Now at this time this matter coming on for the consideration of the State Engineer, and it appearing that in the decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County in the matter of the determination of rights to the waters of Rogue River and its tributaries (p. 16, col. 2) a water right from Qoleman Creek, tributary of Bear Creek, was allowed to Theo. J. Fish, with priority of 1880, for the appropriation of 0.25 second foot of water for the irrigation of 20 acres of land described as follows: 14 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, and 6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 38 S. R. 1 W. W. M.; that recent negotiations in regard to said water rights have developed the fact that the lands described by said decree, and upon which the water under said right has been used, were incorrectly described in said decree; and that the correct description of the lands is as follows: 14 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 16, T. 38 S. R. 1 W. W. M.; and it further appearing that said error should be corrected and that no injury will be caused thereby, it is ORDERED that in the record of said water right in this office, said description be changed as above indicated, and at such time as a final water right certificate is issued covering said right, the correct description be incorporated therein.
