ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705 and ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6871 submitted by

SILVER LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT c/o ZX RANCH P.O. BOX 7 PAISLEY, OREGON 97636

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 49857, was perfected under Permit 11656 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 11, 1915. The right allows the use of SILVER CREEK, EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR and DIVERSION DAM RESERVOIR, a tributary of SILVER LAKE (dry), for IRRIGATION OF 117.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.06 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized points of diversion: NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 24, T 30 S, R 13 E, W.M.; CREEK-2,800 FEET SOUTH and 500 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 24; SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 17, T 30 S, R 14 E W.M.; E.T.V. RESERVOIR-600 FEET NORTH and 1,700 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 17; Lot 1 (NE¼ NE¼,) SECTION 5, T 29 S, R 14 E, W.M.; D.D. RESERVOIR-

This is an order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order

100 FEET SOUTH and 1300 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 5; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR and DIVERSION DAM RESERVOIR constructed under permit R-680.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 49859, was perfected under Permit 29955 with a date of priority of AUGUST 24, 1964. The right allows the use of EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR a tributary of SILVER CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 117.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 89.46 ACRE FEET if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE% SW%, SECTION 17, T 30 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 600 FEET NORTH and 1,700 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 17, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to STORED WATER ONLY and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR constructed under permit R-4461.

The third right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 76234, was perfected under Permit G-6670, Transfer 6503, with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. The right allows the use of WELLS 2 and 3 in the FORT ROCK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 16.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second, if available at the original points of appropriation: SW% SE%, SECTION 21; SE% NW%, SECTION 27; SW% NW%, SW% SW%, SECTION 27; T 27 S, R 19 E, WM; WELL 14 - 930 FEET NORTH AND 1570 FEET WEST; WELL 15 - 1910 FEET SOUTH AND 3110 FEET WEST; WELL 16 - 1630 FEET SOUTH AND 220 FEET EAST; ALL FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 27; WELL 17 - 410 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 27.

The authorized points of appropriation are located as follows:

NW% NE%, SECTION 26; NW% NW%, SECTION 25; T 28 S, R 14 E, W.M.; WELL 2 - 728 FEET SOUTH AND 3,144 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 26; WELL 3 - 688 FEET SOUTH AND 1166 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the authorized points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.

The wells shall be maintained to the well construction standards in effect as of May 10, 1991, and must include an access port.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install inline flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The types and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

The authorized place of use from SILVER CREEK, EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR and DIVERSION DAM RESERVOIR (PERMIT 11656) AND EAST THOMPSON VALLEY RESERVOIR (PERMIT 29955) is located as follows:

The proposed changes shall be completed on or before 1. October 1, 2001.

- 2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor the accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.
- 4. The former places of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificates 49857, 49859 and 76234 are canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
