An affidavit was received from MYRON L. and SHARON G. BUCK, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and they request that it be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 3529, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.42 cubic foot per second from SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1909. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 32.7 acres.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.7 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4 25.0 ACRES
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 3529 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
